This is a hands-on role, and you will be involved in the daily diving activities as well as delivering dive experiences for the public.

About You

You will need to be organised and proactive with a real passion for Diving. Previous experience of working in a Dive site environment is essential and ideally you will also have proven diver training experience in a customer focused dive environment.

As you will be assisting in the management of a small team of part time divers, you should be able to demonstrate in your application strong leadership and communication skills.

Ideal candidates will have an understanding and awareness of UK health and safety dive legislation along with the ability to use their initiative; self motivated and an excellent communicator.

Other responsibilities include assisting in the completing and regularly reviewing Dive procedures and risk assessments, ensuring the maintenance of Dive equipment is carried out and assisting the Curator to ensure well maintained displays throughout the attraction.

The post holder will be required to work 40 hours per week including regular weekends and bank holidays.
